Regulatory framework of the international cooperation in education sphere (Russian experience)

The article is devoted to evaluation of the integration of Russia into the international educational area. The authors consider the agreements in the education sphere that have been ratified by Russian Federation. Also the authors note the ways of systematic and consistent convergence of the international legal institutions in relation to the legal regulation of the education system.
