International legal basis of application of the Armed Forces of Ukraine abroad and problems of implementation as an example peacekeeping operations in Yugoslavia and Iraq

Article is devoted to the legal framework of Ukraine's participation in international peacekeeping activities, analysis of international instruments of the United Nations, NATO, the last few years to maintain international peace and security.
